Databricks Student Fellows Program

Terms and Conditions

Effective Date: August 3, 2026

THESE STUDENT FELLOWS PROGRAM TERMS AND CONDITIONS (THESE “TERMS”) ARE ENTERED INTO BETWEEN THE PARTICIPATING STUDENT (“YOU” OR “YOUR”) AND DATABRICKS, INC. (“DATABRICKS”). THESE TERMS GOVERN YOUR PARTICIPATION IN THE DATABRICKS STUDENT FELLOWS PROGRAM (THE “PROGRAM”). THESE TERMS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE FROM TIME TO TIME AT DATABRICKS’ SOLE DISCRETION. DATABRICKS WILL PROVIDE SEVEN (7) DAYS NOTICE OF ANY MATERIAL UPDATE. YOUR CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN THE PROGRAM CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THE UPDATED TERMS. IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO REVIEW AND COMPLY WITH THE MOST CURRENT VERSION. BY SELECTING “I AGREE,” ACCEPTING AN INVITATION TO THE PROGRAM, OR OTHERWISE PARTICIPATING IN THE PROGRAM, YOU REPRESENT THAT YOU ARE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE THAT YOU HAVE READ AND UNDERSTOOD THESE TERMS, AND YOU AGREE TO BE LEGALLY BOUND BY THEM AS AN INDIVIDUAL. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO THESE TERMS, DO NOT ACCEPT THEM OR PARTICIPATE IN THE PROGRAM.

1. Eligibility

To participate in the Program, You must (a) be at least 18 years of age; (b) be currently enrolled as a student at an accredited educational institution; (c) have received and accepted an invitation from Databricks to participate; and (d) not be a Databricks employee, contractor, or temporary worker. Databricks may establish additional eligibility criteria for the Program and may verify Your eligibility at any time. Databricks may suspend or remove You from the Program if You no longer meet these criteria. By participating in the Program you represent, warrant, and agree that your participation is in compliance with the law and any employer or school policies that may apply to you. You agree to notify Databricks promptly if any of the above eligibility criteria change during Your participation in the Program.

2. Program Benefits and Applicable Terms

As part of the Program, You may receive access to certain benefits, which may include certification exam vouchers, access to the Databricks platform (including the Databricks Free Edition), Databricks Academy training resources, and other opportunities Databricks makes available to Program participants from time to time (collectively, “**Program Benefits**”). Program Benefits are provided to You free of charge, are personal to You, and are non-exclusive, non-transferable, and non-sublicensable. Program Benefits are provided for educational and professional development purposes and do not constitute compensation for services. Program Benefits are offered at Databricks’ discretion and may be changed, limited, or discontinued at any time without notice. Certain Program Benefits are governed by their own separate terms, which may apply to Your use of those benefits in addition to these Terms, including the:

3. Your Responsibilities

As a Databricks Student Fellow, You represent not only Yourself but also help represent Databricks, and You agree to act professionally, lawfully, and with integrity. You agree to comply with all applicable laws and with the [Databricks Third Party Code of Conduct](#), as applicable to Program activities. Without limitation, You agree that You will not: (a) engage in harassing, discriminatory, defamatory, deceptive, or unlawful conduct; (b) misrepresent Your affiliation with Databricks or make any representation, warranty, or commitment on Databricks' behalf; (c) accept personal payment, gifts, or other personal financial benefit from any third party in exchange for promoting Databricks or the Program; for clarity, this does not prohibit standard event sponsorships, venue support, or similar arrangements that are coordinated with or approved in advance by Databricks; (d) make any public statement that purports to be an official Databricks statement; (e) use the Program or any Program Benefit for any unlawful or competitive purpose; or (f) when creating or posting content that promotes Databricks or the Program, fail to clearly disclose Your status as a Databricks Student Fellow in compliance with applicable advertising disclosure laws and guidelines. When hosting or organizing events in connection with the Program, You agree to follow the relevant university's event policies and to conduct yourself professionally and in accordance with applicable law. Databricks may take any action it deems appropriate in response to a violation, including removing You from the Program.

4. Use of the Student Fellow Designation and Databricks Marks

For so long as You are an active participant in good standing, Databricks grants You a personal, non-exclusive, non-transferable, revocable license to identify Yourself as a "Databricks Student Fellow" and to use any badge or designation that Databricks provides for that purpose (the "Fellow Designation"), solely to indicate Your participation in the Program.

You agree to use the Fellow Designation and any Databricks names, logos, or trademarks ("Databricks Marks") only as authorized by Databricks.

5. Confidential Information

In connection with the Program, Databricks may share information that is identified as confidential or that You should reasonably understand to be confidential, including non-public information about products, features, roadmaps, and pre-release or beta offerings ("Confidential Information"). You will not use Confidential Information except for purposes of the

Program, and You will not disclose it to any third party, in each case until Databricks makes it publicly available.

6. Intellectual Property

6.1 You retain ownership of content You independently create in connection with the Program (“Your Content”), subject to the licenses below. Databricks owns all right, title, and interest in and to the Program, the Program Benefits, the Databricks Marks, and all materials Databricks provides to You.

6.2 **Databricks Content.** To the extent You create content for or on behalf of Databricks or post content to any channel or account owned or operated by Databricks (“Databricks Content”), You hereby assign to Databricks all right, title, and interest in and to that Databricks Content.

6.3 **License to Your Content.** You grant Databricks a worldwide, non-exclusive, royalty-free, fully paid-up, sublicensable, and transferable license to use, reproduce, distribute, display, perform, modify, and adapt Your Content for Databricks’ marketing, promotional, and related business purposes. You represent that You have all rights necessary to grant this license and that Your Content does not infringe any third-party rights. To the extent permitted by law, You waive any moral rights in Your Content.

6.4 **Feedback.** If You provide Databricks with suggestions, ideas, or other feedback regarding the Program or any Databricks products or services (“Feedback”), such Feedback is non-confidential, and You grant Databricks a perpetual, irrevocable, worldwide, royalty-free, and sublicensable license to use and exploit the Feedback for any purpose without restriction or compensation to You. You acknowledge that Databricks may already be considering or developing similar ideas.

7. Publicity; Name, Image, and Likeness; Recordings

By participating in the Program, You grant Databricks the right to use Your name, likeness, image, voice, professional title, statements, and Your school affiliation (collectively, “Your Attributes”), and to record, photograph, and film You at Program events, for advertising, marketing, promotional, and related purposes, in any media now known or later developed, worldwide and without further notice, approval, payment, or other consideration, except where prohibited by law. Databricks owns all such recordings. You waive any claims based on Databricks’ use of Your Attributes as permitted above, including claims based in rights of publicity or privacy, except where such waiver is prohibited by law.

8. No Employment, Agency, or Compensation

Your participation in the Program does not create any employment, agency, partnership, joint venture, or fiduciary relationship between You and Databricks, and You and Databricks are independent of one another. Your participation in the Program is entirely voluntary, and You are under no obligation to devote any minimum amount of time or effort to Program activities. You have no authority to assume or create any obligation on Databricks' behalf or to represent Databricks as an agent or employee. You are not entitled to any wages, compensation, or employee benefits from Databricks for participating in the Program, for creating any Databricks Content, or otherwise. You are solely responsible for determining and satisfying any tax obligations that may arise from Your participation in the Program or Your receipt of Program Benefits.

9. Privacy

Databricks handles Your personal information in connection with the Program in accordance with the [Databricks Privacy Notice](#).

10. Disclaimer of Warranties

The Program, the Program Benefits, and all related materials are provided on an "as is" and "as available" basis. Databricks makes no warranties of any kind, whether express, implied, statutory, or otherwise, and specifically disclaims all implied warranties, including any implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, title, and non-infringement, to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law. Databricks does not warrant that the program or any Program Benefit will be available, uninterrupted, or error-free. To the extent applicable law does not allow the foregoing exclusions, they will apply to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law.

11. Limitation of Liability

In no event will Databricks or its affiliates, or their respective directors, officers, employees, or agents, be liable for any indirect, special, incidental, exemplary, consequential, or punitive damages, or for any lost profits, revenue, or goodwill, arising out of or relating to the Program or these Terms, however caused and under any theory of liability, whether or not Databricks has been advised of the possibility of such damages. These limitations form an essential basis of the bargain between the parties.

12. Governing Law; Venue

The governing law and exclusive venue applicable to any lawsuit or other dispute arising in connection with the Program will be determined according to the “Governing Law and Venue” provision of Databricks’ Master Cloud Services Agreement, available at <https://www.databricks.com/legal/mcsa>.

13. Termination

Databricks may terminate or suspend Your participation in the Program, and revoke any Program Benefit, at any time and with or without cause, in its sole discretion, and without liability to You. You may withdraw from the Program at any time. Upon expiration, withdrawal, or termination, Your rights under these Terms (including Your right to use the Fellow Designation and Databricks Marks) cease immediately. The following provisions survive expiration or termination of these Terms for any reason: Section 5 (Confidential Information), Section 6 (Intellectual Property), Section 7 (Publicity; Name, Image, and Likeness; Recordings), Section 10 (Disclaimer of Warranties), Section 11 (Limitation of Liability), Section 12 (Governing Law; Venue), and Section 14 (General Provisions).

14. General Provisions

14.1 Indemnification. You will defend, indemnify, and hold harmless Databricks and its affiliates, and their respective directors, officers, employees, and agents, from and against any claims, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, and expenses (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of or related to (i) Your violation of these Terms, (ii) Your conduct in connection with Program activities, or (iii) any claim that Your Content infringes a third party's rights.

14.2 Entire Agreement. These Terms, together with any terms incorporated by reference, are the entire agreement between You and Databricks regarding the Program and supersede all prior or contemporaneous representations, discussions, or agreements relating to the Program.

14.3 Severability. If any provision of these Terms is found to be invalid or unenforceable, that provision will be modified to the minimum extent necessary to make it enforceable, and the remaining provisions will continue in full force and effect.

14.4 No Waiver. Databricks' failure to enforce any provision of these Terms will not constitute a waiver of its right to enforce that provision or any other provision in the future.
